

Hello Everyone,

I would first like to thank you and your children for signing up to participate in the "Physical Night" fundraiser to benefit the CC Athletic Department. During the year, I learned of the need to offer immunizations during this time because some health professionals will require another physical before administering the necessary vaccines. In order to help make this event an all-inclusive effort we will have a pharmacist on hand to provide this service. During the physical night, we are including an option for those jr. /sr. high school and sixth grade students to receive their immunizations here. Jill Biss, the Walgreens Pharmacist that also serviced us during the flu season, will be here this Monday, April 11, 2016 between 3:30pm & 6:45pm to provide Menactra (MCV4) and Tdap (Adacel) vaccines to anyone needing to receive these for the upcoming 2016-2017 school year.

Jill will have the option to bill individual insurance plans, but we will need to collect the cost of the vaccine up front. If your insurance covers the cost of the vaccine your check will be returned to you or destroyed. The cost of the Menactra (MCV4) is \$134 and Tdap (Adacel) is \$64.

I have attached a copy of the ISDH recommendations for the 2016-2017 year. The recommendations are according to the grade your child (ren) will enter next school year.
